
Zacchaeus: The Tree Climber



Luke 19:1-10

What exactly did Zacchaeus climb to reach the path of Salvation?

1. He forsook his pride under the tree

- He was prepared to sacrifice his pride, his reputation, and his self- respect in order to see Jesus.
- Lost sheep are more easily found in this way. There he was in the tree, standing out by his humility and self-abasement.

2. He climbed over the mountain of the love of money that hinders many from following the Lord

3. He overcame the weakness of pitying oneself and complaining against God

4. He ascended above the temptation of holding a grudge against those who murmured in opposition to the Lord's visit to his house
