1. When reviled, we should NOT revile in return

“..who, when He was reviled, did not revile in return”

1 Peter 2:23

2. If we must suffer, then it should not be because of us

“But when you do good and suffer, if you take it patiently, this is commendable before God”

1 Peter 2:20

3. We ought to submit to those ruling over us, even if they are harsh

“Servants, be submissive to your masters with all fear, not only to the good and gentle, but also to the harsh”

1 Peter 2:18

4. We ought to wait upon God who judges righteously

“when He suffered, He did not threaten, but
committed Himself to Him who judges
righteously”

1 Peter 2:23

5. The lesson from the Lord's response: "Pursue objectivity"

"For to this you were called, because Christ also
suffered for us, leaving us an example, that you
should follow His steps"
