HOW DOES GOD EXPRESS HIS LOVE FOR US?


He wants to spend time with us

- "If we confess our sins, He is faithful and just to forgive us our sins and to cleanse us from all unrighteousness." (1 Jn. 1:9)




He offers us gifts – for FREE
