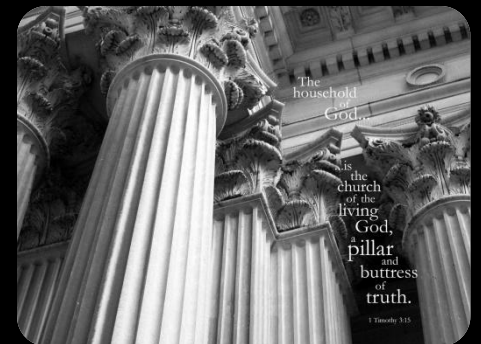
1. Faith and the Church ⁽¹⁾

- God's image: How does He love us?
- “If anyone competes in athletics, he is not crowned unless he competes according to the rules” *2 Timothy 2:5*



1. Faith and the Church ⁽²⁾

- The unchangeable faith: “exhorting you to contend earnestly for the faith which was once for all delivered to the saints” *Jude 3*
- The Church: The pillar and foundation of the Truth (*1 Timothy 3:14*)

- Life without rules



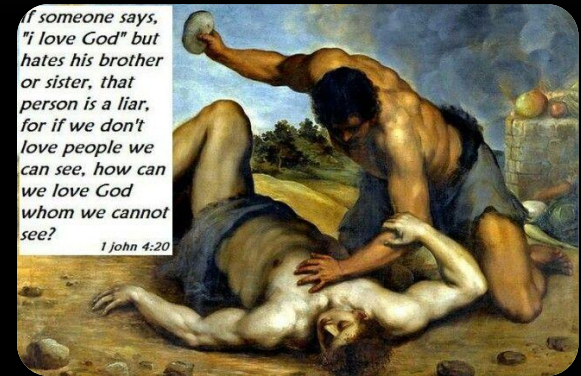
2. Their reality and that of the world ⁽²⁾

Isaiah 29:13



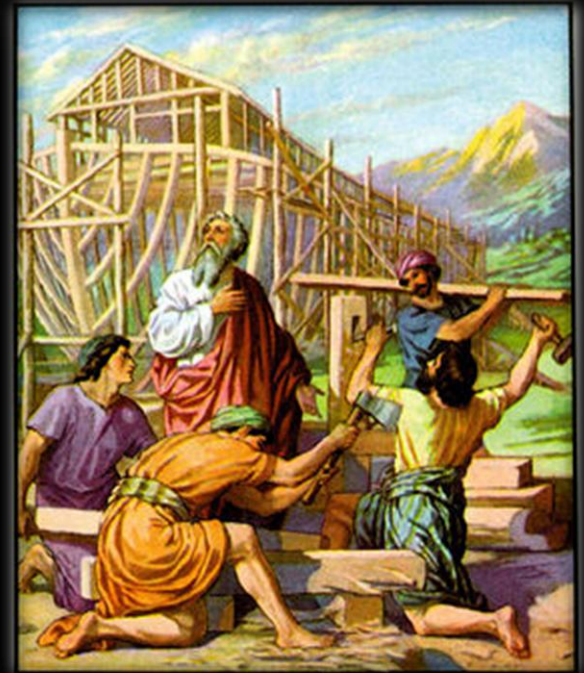
4. Solid Principles ⁽¹⁾
