


Three persons – Three levels (2)

The Son of the Widow of Nain:

Luke 7

- Death went outside in the streets
- Committing the act
- "He came and touched the open coffin"
- "And He presented him to his mother."



Three persons – Three levels (3)

- Lazarus: John 11
 - "there is a stench"
 - Sin as a tyrant master
 - "He cried with a loud voice"
 - "Loose him, and let him go"



Kinds of Strings (1)

- Bad habits addictions
- Rotten attitude:
 - An inability to admit wrongdoing
 - Failing to forgive
 - Petty jealousy
 - Critical spirit



Kinds of Strings (2)

- Personality disorders:
 - Narcissistic
 - Paranoid
 - Antisocial
 - Avoidant



Kinds of Strings (3)

- III temper:
 - Anger
 - Complaining
 - Anxiety
 - Mood swings



Lingering sins: bad mouth, uncontrolled senses, etc.

 - Thoughts of fornication
 - Bad temper
