
Necessity of Obedience



Lesson in Obedience from Four Fishermen

- 1. They stated their reason but did not allow it to supersede their faith.
- 2. Their obedience was immediate
- 3. They did not become preoccupied by the gift (fish) that they forgot the gift-giver.
- 4. They were willing to sacrifice
 - Obedience compliance with an order, request, or law or submission to another's authority
