
- And all the multitudes were amazed and said, "Could this be the Son of David?" (Matt. 12:23)

 - Samson
 - Pharisees






2. Does it cause Division?

"He who is not with Me is against Me, and he who does not gather with Me scatters abroad." (Matt. 12:30)

- Will it cause division in the gospel or confuse the truth?
 - "Do you suppose that I came to give peace on earth? I tell you, not at all, but rather division." (Lk. 12:51)
