

Facts we must know about God

- God disciplines out of love
 - "My son, do not despise the chastening of the Lord, Nor detest His correction; For whom the Lord loves He corrects, Just as a father the son in whom he delights." (Prov. 3:11-12)



Facts we must know about God

- God's mercy is boundless
 - The Samaritan woman
 - God accepts the slightest repentance



Facts we must know about God

- God is always seeking our return
 - Nothing can prevent our reconciliation
 - Lost Son
 - The Corinthian sinner
 - "...deliver such a one to Satan for the destruction of the flesh, that his spirit may be saved in the day of the Lord Jesus." (1 Cor. 5:5)



When Tempted with Despair

Keep fighting

- "You have not yet resisted to bloodshed, striving against sin." (Heb. 12:4)
- "But he who endures to the end shall be saved." (Mk. 13:13)
- "We need not mourn over the dead but over the soul that may not be able to return to God." (St. John Chrysostom)

Death of King David's son

- "So David arose from the ground, washed and anointed himself, and changed his clothes; and he went into the house of the Lord and worshiped. Then he went to his own house; and when he requested, they set food before him, and he ate." (2 Sam. 12:20)
- "While the child was alive, I fasted and wept; for I said, 'Who can tell whether the Lord will be gracious to me, that the child may live?' But now he is dead; why should I fast? Can I bring him back again? I shall go to him, but he shall not return to me." (2 Sam. 12:22-23)

When Tempted with Despair

- It's not about falling, but about getting up
 - The Lost Son
 - "For a righteous man may fall seven times and rise again, But the wicked shall fall by calamity." (Prov. 24:16)



When Tempted with Despair

- Do not separate yourself from God and the Church
 - "I am the vine, you are the branches. He who abides in Me, and I in him, bears much fruit; for without Me you can do nothing. If anyone does not abide in Me, he is cast out as a branch and is withered; and they gather them and throw them into the fire, and they are burned." (Jn. 15:5-6)
