


The Satisfaction in Christ (3)

- 6. The acceptance of earthly loss without the pressing grief
- 7. The ability to submit to God's will in faith



The Race set before us (1)

1. The conviction that satisfaction will never be attained by acquiring more or switching what we have with something newer or better



The Race set before us (2)

2. Ceasing from looking outside for anything or any person that can lead us to satisfaction



3. The personal relationship with the Lord Christ

4. The continual repentance and living in subjection to the work of the Spirit in us



5. Shifting our spiritual practices from mere rituals to real fellowship with the Lord Christ

6. Adjusting the focus to be on the Lord Christ only in all what we do
