

#### Causes (1)

#### 1. Lawlessness:

- ✓ It hardens the heart towards God and others
- ✓ It turns the focus to oneself –
  selfishness mind of
  consumerism



### Causes (2)

#### 2. A thorny ground:

- Busyness with many unprofitable activities
- ✓ Worries and desires of riches
- ✓ Being captivated by innumerable images and news



## Causes (3)

#### 3. Isolation:

- ✓ From God
- ✓ From each other: plugged into technology not people
- ✓ "A man who isolates himself seeks his own desire" Proverbs 18:1
- 4. Stinginess: in sharing oneself with others


#### Manifestations

- Lack of empathy and willingness to understand others
- Shallow spiritual practices
- 3. Defensiveness and anger while dealing with one another
- 4. Slipping into a status of hunger and dissatisfaction



### Outcomes (1)

- Growing in a hostile and unstable environment
- Lacking the understanding and appreciation for God's love and care
- Broken relationships
