What keeps us from constructively receiving rebuke?

- PRIDE
- "He who corrects a scoffer gets shame for himself, And he who rebukes a wicked man only harms himself." (Prov. 9:7)
- "A wise son heeds his father's instruction, But a scoffer does not listen to rebuke." (Prov. 13:1)
- "Surely He scorns the scornful, But gives grace to the humble." (Prov. 3:34)



What keeps us from constructively receiving rebuke?

DISHONESTY

 "I know your works, that you are neither cold nor hot. I could wish you were cold or hot. 16 So then, because you are lukewarm, and neither cold nor hot, I will vomit you out of My mouth. 17 Because you say, 'I am rich, have become wealthy, and have need of nothing'—and do not know that you are wretched, miserable, poor, blind, and naked..." (Rev. 2:15-17)



How to respond correctly to rebuke?

- 1. Prayer
- 2. Adopt a positive attitude about rebuke ahead of time
- 3. Listen to the rebuke without interruption
- 4. Do not immediately prepare your defense
- 5. Avoid pointing out the rebuker's faults or question their motive

How to respond correctly to rebuke?

Thank the rebuker for loving you enough to rebuke you

 "Open rebuke is better Than love carefully concealed. 6 Faithful are the wounds of a friend, But the kisses of an enemy are deceitful." (Prov. 27:5-6)

7. Thank God for the rebuke

 "It is good for me that I have been afflicted, That I may learn Your statutes." (Ps. 119:71)



How to respond correctly to rebuke?

- 8. Seek unbiased counsel
- 9. Confess to the person you injured and to God
