 The ability to influence and lead is proportionate to the success of communications.

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I. IMPORTANCE (2)

- Family members' understanding of their roles and expectations
- Effective participation, loyalty, and cooperation
- 6. Passing of the experience
- Early corrections of mistakes and errors



II. MODES (1)

Verbal and non-verbal:

"But when he was still a great way off, his father saw him and had compassion, and ran and fell on his neck and kissed him"

Luke 15:20

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II. MODES (2)

- Positive and Negative:
 - ✓ Positive: Edifies, encourages, draw people closer to each other
 - ✓ Negative: destroys, discourages, increase gaps



II. MODES (3)

Effective and less effective:

✓ Words: 7%

✓ Voice tone: 38%

✓ Body language: 55%



III. OBSTACLES (1)

It needs participation and cooperation of a sender and a recipient to be effective

 - The Lord Christ and St. Peter at the Lake of Tiberius



IV. SUCCESSFUL COMMUNICATIONS (2)

- 2. Answering the questions in the mind of the recipient:
 - Do you care?
 - Do you understand?
 - Can I trust you?
 - Can you help me?



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IV. SUCCESSFUL COMMUNICATIONS (3)

- 3. The art of positive listening:
 - Asking questions to clarify a point and let the other side express himself/herself clearly
 - The Lord Christ with Adam and Eve, the father with the older son, the Lord Christ with the Samaritan woman



IV. SUCCESSFUL COMMUNICATIONS (4)

- 4. Focus on the other side in the communication:
 - To win the person or prevail in the discussion?
 - Understand the reasons, giving hope, warning: God with Cain
