Sermon Structure


- + Traditional: introduction, body, and conclusion.
- + Short introduction that is fit for the subject.
 - Related or marginally related; seemingly unrelated.
 - † Story, question, thought, background, ...
- + Should be short not 30 mins!
- + Can skip introduction and go straight to the body:
 - Pope Shenouda
- + Practical structure: body, practical application, exercise - something that people can actually do;
 - "giving", exercise: find a poor person, get him a meal.

Huge Topic

- + Topics that can't be covered in one sermo
 - + Faith, Sin, Repentance
 - † Cover one single sub-topic well
- + Providing little information, with long tedious explanations
 - Long introductions
 - Long explanations of small matters that belittles people's mentality

Boring

Repetitious

Well-known topics covered repetitively

· "Boundaries" always starts from the beginning Using the same illustrations over and over



Memorized

Just repeating what is memorized without any "life"

Unattractive

- **+** Topic itself is not attractive
 - Numbers 7:
 - who gave what for the first Tabernacle
 - * Genealogy of Christ
- + Unattractive topic title
 - t "What is the church"
 - "I will build my church"
 - "The essential part of the Lord's plan"
 - "You cannot live this new life in isolation"
- + Unattractive introduction

Unfit

- + Unfit topics
 - † "Marriage", for Middle School students
 - † "Homosexuality", in a general meeting
 - * "Jonah the Prophet", in a funeral
 - * "Fasting", during Holy Pentecost
- + Unfit Behavior
 - Knocking, hitting, yelling, funny motions

+ Unfit verses: in a funeral

- "The Lord has need of him'
- "A living dog is better than a dead lion'
- + Incorrect verses








Overloading
