The Lord's Compassion


"When the Lord saw her, He had compassion on her and said to her, 'Do not weep.'" (Luke 7:13)


Divine Intervention


God's Greater Plan

Hannah's Anguish

"To be honest with God in our grief is to trust Him with our whole heart. Naomi's loyalty bore fruit because it was grounded in sincere love." (St. Augustine)


3 Loyalty in Loss

Sorrow associated with Grief and Suffering



"Though He slay me, yet will I trust Him." (Job 13:15)

1 Mirror of Endurance

"Job is the mirror of faithful endurance. Even in his questioning, he did not forsake God but clung to the hope of divine deliverance." (St. Gregory the Great)

Soul's True Anchor

"Faithfulness in suffering reveals the soul's true anchor. Job's heart clung to God when all else was taken." (Abba Aghathon)



Sorrow from a Lost Soul

The Son's Realization

"I will arise and go to my father, and will say to him, 'Father, I have sinned against heaven and before you.'" (Luke 15:18)

The Father's Joy

"For this my son was dead and is alive again; he was lost and is found." (Luke 15:24)

The Power of Repentance

Breaking of Bread

Liturgy and Revelation

"In the breaking of the bread, Christ is made known to us. The liturgy is where heaven and earth meet, and sorrow becomes joy." (St. Cyril of Jerusalem)



Eucharist and Joy

"The Eucharist is the life of the soul. In it, Christ reveals Himself, changing our grief into rejoicing." (Abba Pambo)





Sorrow associated with Death

Christ's Power Over Death

"Then He came and touched the open coffin, and those who carried him stood still. And He said, 'Young man, I say to you, arise.'" (Luke 7:14)

Resurrection and Life

"Christ is the resurrection and the life. He alone lifts the veil of death and brings the joy that sorrow cannot extinguish." (St. Irenaeus)
